

Fishing and rules for Upper and Lower Neverfjord Water and river between lakes:

It is only permitted to fish for freshwater fish with rod and line from 1. February to 31 August.

Fishing licenses, DISINFECTING, credentials ETC.

Whoever should buy a fishing license, must meet the requirements for disinfection (Gyrodactylus Salaris)

The fisherman is responsible for holding disinfection certificate BEFORE fishing starts.

Disinfection station approved by the association exists on Skaidi Stabbursdalen Lakselv, Børselv. And Kvalsund.

Upper and Lower Neverfjord Water and river between these two lakes included in the anadromous stretch, therefore apply provisions on disinfection of fishing equipment, etc.

All from the age of 18 must pay a fishing fee and have a valid fishing charge card when fishing during the period June 1 - August 31, although it can only be fished for freshwater fish. The reason is that this is anadromous stretch.

Fishing equipment and other pestiferous used outside the county boundaries and / or in waterways where it is proven, or suspected infectious disease shall be disinfected. Otherwise the always fishing gear and other potential pestiferous must be dry before it is used in one other waterways.

Anyone who shall exercise fishing must be accompanied by the following: **Valid license, valid fishing fee, proof of identity, and a certificate of satisfactory disinfection of fishing gear etc. according to regulations.** This and fishing gear in use and catches must be presented upon request fram guard. Licenses can not be lent, sold or transferred to others. People under 18 do not need fishing fee card. Fishing rules also apply to anyone who will engage in ice fishing. Rules on fishing permits, fishing fee, use of equipment and who must disinfect see below:

Fishermen permanent residents of Finnmarkseiendommen (FeFo):

Fast residents in Finnmarkseiendommen (FeFo) fish for free and do not need a fishing license, but must carry the following: Domicile certificate (under 18 years parental residence certificate), proof of identity and disinfection certificate. Domicile certificate obtained from the tax authorities.

All over 18 must have a valid fishing fee cards by fishing inland, in the period June 1st - August 31th.

Disinfection:

If you have used fishing gear and other infectious objects such as wading gear, boats etc. outside the Finnmarkseiendommen (FeFo), water bodies where it is proven, or suspected contagious disease must have disinfection certificate. Otherwise, you do not need disinfection certificate.

Fishermen settled outside Finnmarkseiendommen (FeFo), and foreigners:

The fisherman must have a valid fishing license, credentials and disinfection certificate for fishing in Neverfjord waters.

All over 18 must have a valid fishing toll cards by Inland fishing in the period June 1st - August 31th.

Fishermen under 16 years old and from the age of 67 do not need a fishing license, irrespective of residence / country, but these must bring with them a valid age identification, in order to hold free fishing.

Disinfection for residents outside Finnmarkseiendommen (FeFo) and foreigners:

Everyone must have a disinfection certificate BEFORE fishing starts. This applies to all age groups.

Fishing for salmon, sea trout and Arctic char are prohibited.

Salmon, sea trout and Arctic char must be treated gently and put into water / river by catching, with the exception of salmon and pink salmon that will be addressed by water / river and killed by hunting.

Rules Fishing Tackle:

There are prohibitions on the use of equipment for electronic search of fish. It is not allowed to use any kind of motor boat or other floating equipment. It is prohibited to fish with standing lines, nets, line, ruse, or craw. Fishing with shrimp as bait is prohibited. Fishing with live fish as bait is prohibited. Dead fish from the same water is allowed as bait. It is prohibited to fish in such a way that the fish can be snagged. When fishing in the river between the Upper and Lower Neverfjord Water is forbidden to fish from a boat or other floating equipment. It is only allowed to fish with one rod or one hand line at a time pr. person. Fishing should not be left unattended during the fishery. In the river between Upper and Lower Neverfjord Water is the only permitted to fish with a rod by the same rules as for rod fishing from shore.

Fishing with hand lines from boats, or other floating tool in Upper and Lower Neverfjord Water:

It can not be used more than a total of 3 hooks (a triple hook or so-called anchor counted as three hooks). It is allowed to fish with fly, live and artificial mark with sinkers, lures, spinners and wobblers, with only one anchor, and with a maximum of one suspension.

Example 1: When using lures with triple hook (3 hooks), it can not be used suspension).

Example 2: When using lures with double hook (2 hooks), can often. use a single hook fly that suspension.

Rod fishing from shore or from a boat or from another floating tool:

It can not be used more than a total of 3 hooks (a triple hook or so-called anchor counted as three hooks). It is allowed to fish with fly, live and artificial mark with sinkers, lures, spinners and wobblers, with only one anchor, and with only floater or fly line (maneuverability) who shed weight and maximum one suspension.

Example 1: When using lures with treble hooks (3 hooks), it can not be used suspension).

Example 2: When using lures with double hook (2 hooks), you can use a single hook fly that suspension.

NATURE AND RULES:

All who walk along the Upper and Lower Neverfjord Water obliged to respect the environment and nature. Garbage should be included and not left. Hogging forest and staining of fists is not allowed. Bring firewood or use tumbledown trees. Only use existing fireplaces.

Everyone has a duty to exercise due care when carrying out activities which could lead to fire:

Everyone is obliged to acquaint themselves with, and comply with the prevailing rules on the fire that is determined by the Norwegian government. Hammerfest municipality may have their own rules about fire and everyone is obliged to investigate if such exist, and all are also obliged to comply with such municipal regulations.

It is not allowed to move live fish to and from other rivers, or water.

It is not permitted to clean fish in the lakes, both with regard to risk of infection and order and welfare.

BREACH OF REGULATIONS:

Reactions to violations can be one or more of the following: Fee, expulsion, police report, confiscation of illegal fishing equipment and fishing gear (handed in to the police). Forms of reaction in relation to breaches of the rules are stated on the association's website
